



Lower Providence Township Community Access Channel Cable Message Posting Policy

The Township Manager or his designee prior to posting any cable message on the Community Access Channel will review all cable messages submitted to Lower Providence Township for adherence to the published policy. Methacton School District will be responsible for placing Methacton School related events on the cable channel and will adopt a similar policy. Valid cable message requests from approved organizations will be processed within 2 weeks. Lower Providence Township reserves the right to restrict or remove offensive cable messages and to update this policy at any time.

Approved Organizations

- Lower Providence Township
- Lower Providence Township Library
- Lower Providence Fire Department
- Lower Providence Ambulance
- Lower Providence Township based community organizations
- County, State, Regional, National governmental organizations

Acceptable Cable Messages

- News or current events about approved organizations that inform Lower Providence residents about functions, meetings and events of the approved organization

Unacceptable Cable Messages

- Messages that promote gambling or illegal activities
- Messages that promote political candidates or their views. *General political party organizational meeting announcements will be allowed*
- Messages that promote a political agenda or position
- Messages with paid advertisements or that are for the sole benefit of a commercial or a for profit organization
- Messages using unacceptable language or language that disparages individuals or groups

Posting Requirements

All cable messages must be submitted to the township on the approved Cable Message Posting Form and submitted electronically to the township at the following email address, cablemessage@lowerprovidence.org. Cable messages must be submitted 2 weeks prior to the requested posting start date, so that they may be reviewed by township staff and approved in a timely fashion.
