LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP – Lower Providence Township Emergency Management and Planning personnel and members of the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department Bomb Disposal Unit resumed excavation work this morning at 7 Buckwalter Road in Audubon. Police received a report that approximately 40 sticks of dynamite were buried in the backyard of the single-family residence.

Township Emergency Services personnel remain on site as a precaution. In addition, the following roads are closed: Buckwalter Road from Egypt Road to Lawrence Road, and Mary Bell Road from Buckwalter Road to Crawford Road.

The occupants of two homes in the immediate vicinity of the dig site have been evacuated. Residents of three other homes close to the scene have been asked to remain indoors.

A press briefing is scheduled for this morning at 11:30 a.m. on-site.

The Township Police Department first received the report of the dynamite Wednesday, Aug. 16 at approximately 10 a.m. The Department responded, setting up a perimeter and initially evacuating six homes.
