

MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE

Dear Audubon Water Company Customer:

Effective 7/29/10, Audubon Water Company (Audubon or Company) is implementing Modified mandatory water conservation measures for all customers served by the Audubon water system. Audubon is permitted to impose water use restrictions on its customers under the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Regulation at 52 Pa. Code § 65.11(a). These use restrictions will continue until Audubon provides notice that the mandatory water conservation has been lifted.

Audubon customers are still under the previous Mandatory notice, but Audubon Water is allowing the following activities:

- ▶ The use of hoses, hand held with automatic shut off devices for watering of shrubbery, trees, lawns, grass, plants, vines, gardens, vegetables, flowers or other vegetation
- ▶ The use of water for filling swimming or wading pools.
- ▶ The use of water for fire equipment tests.

Audubon will further lift the water use restrictions as soon as it is safe to do so. The Company greatly appreciates and anticipates that each customer will comply with the use restrictions so that all of the Company's customers will continue to receive safe, adequate and reliable water service.
