CITIZENS BANK ROBBERY AUDUBON VILLAGE SHOPPING CENTER

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (June 7, 2012) - On Thursday, June 7, 2012, at 11:20 A.M., the Lower Providence Township Police Department responded to a report of a robbery at the Citizens Bank, 2806 Audubon Village Drive, in the Audubon Village Shopping Center, which is located in the Audubon section of Lower Providence Township.

A witness observed a suspect on foot on the Pawlings Road side of the Audubon Village Shopping Center when a dye pack exploded. The witness contacted the Lower Providence Township Police Department and reported what had been seen. At the same time, an alarm condition was being reported from the Citizens Bank branch located in the Audubon Village Shopping Center. The witness followed a vehicle that the suspect entered as it travelled on Pawlings Road to Audubon Road to Route 363. The vehicle entered onto Route 422 eastbound as the witness was relating the vehicle description and direction of travel to the Lower Providence Township Police Dispatch Center. The witness discontinued following the suspect's vehicle in the area of the Route 23 interchange.

Officers responding to the bank alarm learned that a white male had entered the bank and approached a teller's station. The suspect handed the teller a note indicating a robbery. The suspect was provided with an undetermined amount of cash and left the bank on foot.

The suspect is described as a white male, in his twenties, approximately 5'6" to 5'8" tall, with facial hair, wearing aviator sunglasses and a tan or brown cap. The vehicle was described as a black Kia sport utility vehicle.

There was no weapon displayed and there were no injuries.

The investigation is being conducted by the Lower Providence Township Police Department and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Anyone with information is requested to contact the Lower Providence Township Police Department at 610-539-5900.
