## **Community Alert**

### **Route 422/363 Interchange Work to Begin**

Work will begin in early October on a \$16.8 million project to build two new ramps at the Route 422/Route 363 (Trooper Road) Interchange. An off-ramp from eastbound Route 422 to Route 363 (Trooper Road) and an on-ramp from Route 363 (Trooper Road) to westbound Route 422 will be built. Construction is scheduled to finish in fall 2015.

In addition, the improvement plan includes realigning the existing Route 363 (Trooper Road) on-ramp to Route 422 east; building a retaining wall and sound wall along the new eastbound Route 422 off-ramp; repairing the existing Route 422 west off-ramp to Route 363 (Trooper Road); building a retaining wall along the new on-ramp to Route 422 west; widening Route 363 (Trooper Road) through the Audubon Road intersection; widening Audubon Road to include an additional turn and merge lane from Route 363 (Trooper Road); rehabilitating the Route 363 (Trooper Road) bridge over Route 422; building a sidewalk on Route 363 (Trooper Road); and installing new traffic signals and curb ramps.

Two travel lanes in each direction will be maintained on Route 422 during construction, with possible lane closures during off-peak hours. Lane closures will occur on Route 363 (Trooper Road) and the project includes a weekend-long closure of the westbound Route 422 off-ramp to Route 363 (Trooper Road) and a six-day closure of Audubon Road.
