

Amusement Tax

Lower Providence Township levies an annual Amusement Tax on the privilege of operating an entertainment facility. The tax is equal to 10% of admission prices to certain places of amusement, entertainment, or recreation. Of the 10% tax, 5% is guaranteed to Lower Providence Township, and 5% is guaranteed to Methacton School District. All Lower Providence Township funds are deposited into the General Fund for operating expenses.

There are two locations that are subject to this tax on an ongoing basis, Collegeville Pit Stop and the Lower Providence Township Rod and Gun Club.

The Township also levies an annual Mechanical Device Tax of \$100.00 for owners of coin-operated machines providing amusement, such as jukeboxes, pinball machines, video games, and pool tables.
