Lower Providence Township is a municipality that is governed as a Township of the Second Class with a Board of Supervisors consisting of five elected residents; each one is elected at large for a six-year staggered term. They are not paid, but do receive a small stipend for their time and expenses. The Board of Supervisors is responsible for the appointment of the Township Manager, who executes the policies of the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors also appoints all advisory and regulatory boards.

CURFEW ORDINANCE No. 274 was enacted to assist with regulating juvenile activities in public places. A juvenile is a person under 18 years of age. The Ordinance restricts all juveniles from public places as follows: 10 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, and from midnight to 6:30 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights.

THE POLICE HOTLINE was established to solicit leads from residents on tobacco, drug and alcohol violators and “party” information. Parents who obtain information of an upcoming drug or alcohol party can report it through the hotline. The police will attempt to notify the parents of the host juvenile prior to the party, in the hopes of preventing a tragedy. Call 610-539-3195.

Things to Keep in Mind

STREET NUMBERS must be visible from the street, posted on the side of the building or on a mailbox, or sign. Numbers must be a minimum of 4" high in a contrasting color to the background. (Ordinance No. 337)

SMOKE DETECTORS are required on every level of all residential dwellings, in each sleeping room, and outside each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of the bedrooms. (Ordinance No. 511)

PERMITS are required for all building expansion, alterations, additions, garages, pools, sheds, patios, decks or driveways. For any change of use to a property, a permit is required. ***Prior to any change to your property, please investigate before you invest. Visit the website for information.***

PROPERTIES ARE TO BE MAINTAINED in a safe, clean and sanitary condition. Owners are required to maintain sidewalks, remove snow from walks and keep their properties free from tall grass, weeds, trash, debris, abandoned appliances or unlicensed vehicles.

TRASH SERVICE must be maintained by all residents with the Township's contracted hauler. (See *Utilities and Waste Removal below.*)

SIDEWALKS

Maintenance - According to Township Ordinance, homeowners are responsible for repair and maintenance of sidewalks. Sidewalks with a horizontal crack or a difference in elevation of more than one inch are considered in an unsafe condition and shall be replaced upon the issuance of a permit by the Township. (Ordinance 534)

Snow Removal – Tenants and owners of properties abutting public streets are required to clear a pathway in the sidewalk at least 30 inches wide within 48 hours after it snow stops snowing/sleeting. They are also to cover the sidewalk with ashes, sawdust or similar materials in the event of ice or sleet. Snow must not be piled or placed in the gutter or roadway. (Ordinance 534)

WATER DISCHARGE – Storm water, surface water, spring water, groundwater, roof runoff, subsurface drainage, building foundation drainage, cellar drainage or drainage from roof leader connections shall not be discharged into any sewer. (Ordinance 169)

EMERGENCY ALARM ORDINANCE No. 301 assists with the regulation of burglar/fire alarms installed in homes/businesses. We recognize the value of these systems, however, the diversion of emergency responders to false alarm calls affects the entire community. The ordinance requires the owner/user to register the alarm system with the Police Department; the Department is available to help you interpret and comply with the ordinance.
