On February 4, 2009, the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) received the above-referenced application for the construction of the middle section of the Oaks interceptor upgrades.

Permit applications undergo a series of reviews before a final decision is rendered by DEP. We have reviewed your application in order to determine whether it contains the information, plans, fees, and other documents necessary for administrative completeness. Please be advised that your application has been determined to be ***administratively incomplete***. Therefore, the application must be revised for DEP to conduct its review. The application may be returned to you for revision and resubmittal. At least, the following items must be included in the resubmittal of your application or the submission of additional information:

Act 537 Approval: The location of the interceptor as proposed in the permit application, specifically the section between Manholes 38 and 53, is not consistent with the location approved under the Act 537 Plan (February 26, 2004). Until this inconsistency is resolved, DEP is unable to take a final action on your permit application.


