### **Fall Fest 2007: Live Music, Business/Health Expo, Family Fun**

**LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP** (*September 25, 2007*) – Lower Providence Township will hold a Fall Fest on Saturday, Sept. 29, offering food, fun and special activities for the entire family. The Fest will be held from noon to 6 p.m. at Eagleville Park, located behind the Township Administration Building, 100 Parklane Drive, Eagleville.

The Fest will include a Business & Health Expo, featuring a variety of local businesses and representatives from area fitness centers, medical centers, chiropractic offices and sports organizations. A “Kids Corner” will offer various performances throughout the day, including a puppeteer, storyteller, clown, children’s band, magician, and more.

Other highlights of the Fest include: “Little Miss & Mr. Lower Providence” talent and Halloween costume pageant, a 3-on-3 Men’s Basketball Tournament, and Pie Eating Contest.
