Medicine Return Box Located in Police Station

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*March 6, 2014*) – A medicine return box is now available at the Lower Providence Township Police Department. The collection box, located in the lobby of the police station, is available Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Any controlled, non-controlled and over the counter medications will be accepted. Liquid products and creams in their original container, along with pet medications will also be accepted. Syringes and illicit substances, such as marijuana, cocaine, methamphetamine and heroin will not be accepted.

Prescription medications need not to be removed from their containers. It is recommended that identifying labels be removed before disposal.

The Medreturn box is sponsored by LPPD, Montgomery County DA's Office, PA District Attorney's Association, PA Commission on Crime and Delinquency, & PA Department of Drug & Alcohol Programs. This program is anonymous and no attempt will be made to identify an individual.
