ALLEGED SERIAL BANK ROBBERS ARRESTED

Christopher LeBlanc, age 40, of Norristown, Pennsylvania, and Elizabeth Kenneally, 25, of Phoenixville, Pennsylvania, were taken into custody at approximately 8 p.m. on Tuesday, November 4, 2014 at a Super 8 Motel on South DuPont Highway, New Castle County, Delaware.

Participating in the arrest: members of the Delaware State Police; Westtown-East Goshen (PA) Police Department; West Goshen (PA) Police Department; Lower Providence Township (PA) Police Department; and agents with the FBI's Wilmington (DE) Resident Agency.

LeBlanc and Kenneally face local charges in connection with the October 28, 2014 robbery of the Citizens Bank branch inside the Giant Food store located at 2668 Egypt Road, Norristown, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, the November 4, 2014 robbery of the Citizens Bank branch inside the Acme Supermarket located at 907 Paoli Pike, West Chester, Chester County, Pennsylvania, one additional Chester County bank robbery, and an area jewelry store robbery.
