**SNOW EMERGENCY DECLARATION**

A snow emergency has been declared for Lower Providence Township from 12:00 AM on Thursday, March 5, 2015 through 12:00 PM on Friday, March 6, 2015 in anticipation of the expected precipitation of heavy snow.

In accordance with the Lower Providence Township Code, Chapter 138, Article IV, the following restrictions are in place under the snow emergency declaration:

1. No vehicle shall be parked on the odd numbered side of the street or any road unless there is no off-street parking available at or within 300 feet of the property;
2. Any person who drives a vehicle without chains or snow tires upon any street or road and allows such vehicle to become stalled or incapable of moving under its own power, or who leaves such vehicle unattended, shall be in violation of the ordinance;
3. Any vehicle parked, stalled, incapable of moving or left unattended upon any street or road may be removed or towed by the Police Department.

Additionally, no person shall deposit snow or have snow deposited upon any street or road in the Township.

Violations of the Ordinance call for a fine of not more than \$50.00, plus the costs of prosecution.
