Township Receives State Grant for Traffic Signal Upgrade

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*May 17, 2016*) - Lower Providence Township received state funding for traffic signal upgrades under the PA Department of Transportation's "Green Light-Go" program. The Township was awarded \$1,041 towards conversion of the Egypt Road and Surrey Lane traffic signal to LED technology.

All 18 traffic signals maintained by the Township have been converted to LED lights, reducing energy and maintenance costs.

Lower Providence was one of 109 municipalities to receive funding this year under the PennDOT program which is made possible by Act 89, the state's transportation funding plan. It establishes partnership agreements between municipalities and PennDOT through which municipalities request up to 50-percent funding for traffic-signal projects.
