Brimfield Road Home Damaged by Fire

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (April 4, 2017) – On Monday, April 3, 2017 at 6:05 PM, a resident in the unit block of Brimfield Road observed smoke coming from his neighbor’s front living room window. Unable to reach his neighbor by phone or by knocking at the doors, the resident alerted 911 who dispatched Lower Providence Township Volunteer Fire Company.

Assistant Fire Chief Stefan Cindrich was first to arrive and was presented with smoke from the home and fire on the second floor. The fire was quickly extinguished and deemed under control by 6:33 pm. The home sustained moderate fire, smoke and water damage. Total Restoration Contracting provided board-up service.

One firefighter experienced a medical episode during the fire and is seeking medical treatment.

Lower Providence Township Fire Marshals Charles DeFrancesco and Ronald Kenwood initiated an investigation. The origin was identified to be on or near a piece of furniture at the second floor landing. The cause is still under investigation.

Assisting agencies were Collegeville Fire Company, Jeffersonville Fire Company, and Norristown Fire Department. Lower Providence Township Police and Lower Providence Ambulance also responded.
