HOME INVASION ROBBERY SUSPECTS ARRESTED

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (November 10, 2009) – Three suspects have been charged by the Lower Providence Township Police Department for their involvement in a home invasion robbery that took place in the 500 block of Seventh Street in the Trooper section of the Township at 7:39 P.M. on Monday, November 9, 2009.

Dayquan Jamal Mayes, 27, of the 400 block of West Street, Pottstown, PA 19464, Dominick Rashad Matthews, 18, of the 100 block of Roland Street, Pottstown, PA 19464, and Shonda L. Brunner, 26, of the 300 block of Lincoln Street, Pottstown, PA 19464 were taken into custody by the Lower Providence Township Police Department with the assistance of the Pottstown Police Department. Mayes and Matthews were taken into custody at a residence in the 300 block of Lincoln Street in Pottstown at approximately 11:40 P.M. on Monday, November 9, 2009. Brunner was taken into custody at 11:40 A.M. on Tuesday, November 10, 2009 in the 200 block of Chestnut Street in Pottstown.

All three have been charged with Robbery, Burglary, Criminal Conspiracy at Robbery, Criminal Conspiracy at Burglary, Criminal Trespass, Theft by Unlawful Taking or Disposition, Receiving Stolen Property, Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance, Unlawful Restraint, and False Imprisonment. They were provided with a preliminary arraignment before Magisterial District Judge Benjamin R. Crahalla of Collegeville. Bail was set at \$1,000,000.00 cash for each of the defendants. They were committed to the Montgomery County Correctional Facility in default of bail. A preliminary hearing has been scheduled for November 19, 2009 at 10:00 A.M. before Magisterial District Judge Crahalla.

The investigation is continuing with respect to additional suspects. Additional information will be released as it is developed. It is requested that anyone with information concerning this incident contact the Lower Providence Township Police Department at 610-539-5900.
