What is the Veterans Memorial/Walk of Honor?

The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors wanted a special way to recognize all veterans, especially those current and former residents of the Township. The Veterans Memorial, erected in front of the Lower Providence Township Administration Building, stands as a symbol of the sacrifice these men and women make for our country. A walkway of landscaping bricks surrounds the memorial. On Memorial Day 2004, Lower Providence Township officially dedicated the Veterans Memorial and Walk of Honor.

What is a Walk of Honor brick?

Current or former residents may purchase a commemorative brick and have it placed in the Walk of Honor. In recognition of contributions of \$25, Lower Providence Township will engrave the brick with the serviceman or woman's name, and his or her rank, branch and date of military service. The program provides a way to honor those brave individuals who are serving, or have served, our country. All proceeds from the sale of the engraved bricks go toward memorial costs.

Even though the bricks are designed for hard use and longevity, Lower Providence Township cannot be responsible for guaranteeing the lifespan for the bricks. Purchaser agrees that the brick may be permanently removed at the discretion of Lower Providence Township without any compensation, refund or recourse owed to the purchaser. Purchaser will have no control over the design, format, material, appearance, construction, manufacture, installation, maintenance, repair, admission, or access to or operation of the brick in the walkway. Purchaser recognizes that the brick may chip, crack, wear or otherwise become damaged due to any cause. Purchaser will not have the right to require that the brick or the walkway be maintained, repaired, replaced, removed or relocated.
