LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the November 5th business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the Consent Agenda, including:
 - <u>Minutes of the October 15, 2020</u> Board of Supervisors' meetings
 - Escrow release No. 13 for Manors at Brynwood in the amount of \$31,395.01
- Approved the <u>preliminary 2021 budget</u> and authorized advertisement of the proposed budget. (2021 budget presentation)
- Approved the request of the Lower Providence Fire Department for waiver of permit fees
- Authorized the advertisement of a fire code ordinance adopting the 2015 edition of the International Fire Code as the fire code of Lower Providence Township
- Authorized the expenditure of funds for a Year-in-Review video production. For the past three years, the supervisors have hosted an open house event to provide residents with updates on current projects and future goals. Because of COVID-19 restraints, an in-person open house is not possible this year. Instead, a year-in-review video will be produced.
