Approvals

- Approved the Consent Agenda, including:
 - Minutes of the Board of Supervisors' Feb. 18, 2021 business meeting
 - Escrow release #2 for Backyard Winery, 3855 Germantown Pike, in the amount of \$7,284.45
 - Escrow release from grading permit for IROY Sports and Fitness, 3444

- Approved a request for waiver of fence standards to permit a chain link-style fence on the corner property at 4013 Killington Road
