The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the April 15, 2021 business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the Consent Agenda, including:
 - Minutes of the Board of Supervisors' March 31, 2021 business meeting
 - Payment of bills in the amount of \$560,364.83
- Approved the Conditional Use Decision for CarVision, allowing overflow parking at 950 Rittenhouse Road and approving a waiver for the fence in the current location without barbed wire
- Approved the Environmental Advisory Council's <u>Storm Water Directive</u>
- Awarded the 2021 road improvements bid, per the recommendation of the Township engineer, to Alan Meyers Inc. Construction; contract value is \$376,076.75
