The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the May 6, 2021 business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the Consent Agenda, including:
 - Minutes of the Board of Supervisors' April 15, 2021 business meeting
 - Escrow Releases
 - Crawford Estates, 37 Crawford Road, in the amount of \$101,275.00
 - Courts at Brynwood, Phase I, in the amount of \$138,195.75
