The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the June 16, 2022 business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the Consent Agenda including:

 - Payment of bills in the amount of \$609,724.79
- Granted a request for waiver of fence standards at 1008 Doris Drive to permit a 6-foot, solid style fence in the front yard along the Vincent Drive frontage.
- Granted a request for waiver of land development for Evansburg Winery, 3855 Germantown Pike, to enclose one of two new pavilions
- Approved a letter of support in favor of a Perkiomen Creek Watershed Act 167 Plan study or other stormwater mitigation study
