

Board of Supervisors' Actions – July 21, 2016 Business Meeting

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*July 22, 2016*) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at their July 21st business meeting:

Presentations & Recognition

- Presented an award to Gil Price recognizing his service to the Lower Providence Parks and Recreation Board as a student representative
- Presented a plaque to representatives of the Lower Providence Community Library commemorating the 20th anniversary of the opening of the current library building and the recent completion of renovations
- Recognized the Audubon Invasion 10U Softball Team, the 10U State and Mid-Atlantic Region Champions. The team will compete in the World Series in Jensen Beach, Fla. starting on Aug. 4.

Ordinances

• Adopted an ordinance establishing the Ridge Pike West Zoning District and amending the Zoning Map to show the new district. The zoning permits a greater mix of uses in the western section of Ridge Pike and is designed to foster redevelopment in the area.

Resolutions

Adopted a resolution accepting reimbursement funding totaling \$1,041 through the PA
Department of Transportation's "Green Light Go" program and designating Interim
Township Manager Alison Rudolf to execute all associated documents. The funding
allowed the Township to replace incandescent signal head bulbs with LED bulbs at the
intersection of Egypt Road and Surrey Lane.

Approvals

- Granted a request for waiver of fence requirements to allow a black vinyl chain link fence to be installed in the front yard at 111 Salem Drive
- Granted a request from St. Andrew's Church for waiver of the \$15 yard sale permit fee
