Board of Supervisors' Actions - Dec. 1, 2016 Business Meeting

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*December 2, 2016*) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at their December 1st business meeting, including adoption of the 2017 Budget that does not raise taxes for residents.
