ORDINANCE NO. 649 (Duly Adopted December 21, 2017)

AN ORDINANCE OF LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 138, ARTICLE III, PARKING REGULATIONS, SECTIONS 138-23 AND 138-25 PROHIBITING PARKING ON CERTAIN ROADS AT ALL TIMES AND PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN ROADS

WHEREAS, the Township has established parking prohibitions and limits upon certain roads within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to amend the parking prohibition at any time on the east side of Clearfield Avenue in the Township from Ridge Pike to Oakdale Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Township also desires to add a parking time limitation from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on the west side of Clearfield Avenue in the Township from Ridge Pike south for 30 feet.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it is hereby **ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors as follows:

ARTICLE I.

Chapter 138, Article III, Section 138-23, "Parking prohibited at all times" is hereby amended as follows:

§138-23. Parking prohibited at all times.

No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the highways or parts thereof described below:

ARTICLE II.

Chapter 138, Article III, Section 138-25, "Parking time limited" is hereby amended as follows:

§138-25. Parking time limited.

No person shall park a vehicle or allow the same to remain parked upon any of the highways or parts of highways described below between the hours specified, for longer than the time indicated below:

Name of Highway [Clearfield Avenue]

Side/Hours and Time Limit

[West side from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.]

Location

[From Ridge Pike south for 30 feet]

ARTICLE III. Repealer

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE IV. Severability

If any section, paragraph, sub-section, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than that portion specifically declared invalid.

ARTICLE V. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after final enactment.
