TO BE NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK IN LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP**

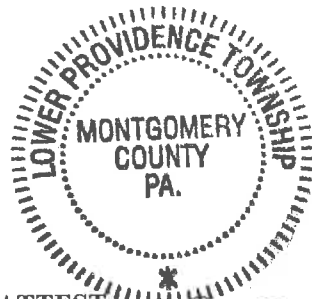
