

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-24

A RESOLUTION OF THE LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPROVING THE RIDGE PIKE WEST CORRIDOR STUDY PREPARED BY McMAHON AND ASSOCIATES, INC.

WHEREAS, the Ridge Pike West corridor extends from approximately Evansburg Road in Lower Providence Township to the Perkiomen Creek; and


WHEREAS, the Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors enacted a Ridge Pike West zoning district to foster redevelopment and renewal of the corridor; and


WHEREAS, the Township, with assistance from the Montgomery County Planning Commission and the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission, initiated a study to identify recommendations in support of a multi-model transportation system in anticipation of new development along the corridor.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors does hereby approve and adopt the Ridge Pike West Corridor Study dated June, 2018 as prepared by McMahon Associates, Inc. and furthermore, the Board of Supervisors adopts the conclusions and recommendations set forth in the report, including the completion of a new connector roadway extending between Ridge Pike and Germantown Pike in the short term and the extension westerly across the Perkiomen Creek of a second Perkiomen Creek bridge.

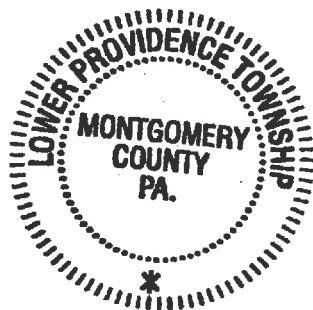
