

## RESOLUTION NO. 17-11

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, DESIGNATING THE LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY AS THE COMPANY TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES AND RELATED EMERGENCY SERVICES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP**

**WHEREAS**, the Lower Providence Township Volunteer Fire Company was formed by court decree dated October 2, 1946 as a non-profit corporation to establish, maintain, and provide fire protection services to the residents of Lower Providence Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Lower Providence Township Volunteer Fire Company have provided exemplary fire protection services to the residents of Lower Providence Township; and

**WHEREAS**, Sections 1801 and 1803 of the Second Class Township Code permit the Board of Supervisors to provide for fire protection within the Township and to make rules and regulations for the government of fire companies located within Lower Providence Township; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 1553 of the Second Class Township Code requires the Township to consult with fire and emergency medical service providers and to ensure that emergency service providers provide to the Township an annual itemized list of all expenditures during the Township's annual budget consideration; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors desires to officially designate the Lower Providence Township Volunteer Fire Company as the sole provider of fire protection services to the residents of Lower Providence in accordance with the Second Class Township Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. That the Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors does hereby designate the Lower Providence Township Volunteer Fire Company ("Fire Company") as the sole provider of fire prevention and protection services within the geographic boundaries of Lower Providence Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania subject to applicable mutual aid agreements with other fire companies and Montgomery County.

2. That the Fire Company and the Township shall at all times comply with Section 1553 of the Second Class Township Code as amended.

**SO RESOLVED**, at a duly convened meeting of the Board of Supervisors conducted on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March, 2017.
