RESOLUTION #2020-10**

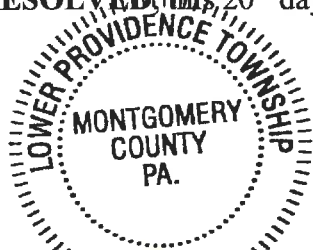
**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 has been declared by the World Health Organization and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention a “public health emergency of international concern”; and

**WHEREAS**, On March 8, 2020, Montgomery County declared a state of emergency due to the identification of affected citizens, and

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2020, Lower Providence Township declared a local disaster emergency.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors hereby extends the local disaster emergency in Lower Providence Township for an additional sixty days from the initial Declaration or until Governor Wolf lifts the state disaster emergency, whichever is later.
