LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*February 16, 2018*) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the February 15th business meeting:

- Authorized a lease agreement with the Lower Providence tax collector for the use of the Shoemaker House on the Township complex
- Approved the Township's application to the Montco 2040 Implementation program and the proposal of Woodrow and Associates to complete a sidewalk assessment as part of the application
