



Board of Supervisors' Actions – March 15, 2018 Business Meeting

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*March 16, 2018*) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the March 15th business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the Consent Agenda, including:
 - Minutes of the March 1, 2018 Board of Supervisors meeting
 - Payment of bills in the amount of \$387,451.12

Ordinances

- Adopted Ordinance #654 – The ordinance establishes regulations concerning the growing, processing and sale of medical marijuana and permits such uses in the Industrial Park (IP) District.
- Adopted Ordinance #655 – The ordinances repeals and replacing Chapter 77 of the Township Code, *Drug Paraphernalia*, to permit the summary charging of possession with the intent to use drug paraphernalia.

Approvals

- Approved a pension benefit distribution
- Approved the proposal of KCBA Architects to conduct a master planning study for the municipal building at a cost of \$19,650.

Discussion

- The preliminary/final land development plan for the expansion project at the Montgomery County Emergency Operations Center was discussed.
- The Supervisors presented their goals for the year: Formation of open space/trails/sidewalks steering committee; Audubon School usage study; contract negotiations with Police and non-uniformed workers; formation of Emergency Services committee; economic development open houses; targeted traffic improvements; increased civic involvement; and Zoning Code review and update.
