

Board of Supervisors' Actions – March 7, 2019 Business Meeting

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*March* 8, 2019) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the March 7th business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the Consent Agenda, including:

- Approved a request from Audubon Land Development for an extension of the review period for Shannondell Phase 3

Ordinances

Adopted Ordinance #658 providing for the regulation of massage providers

Fire Department Commendations

- Lower Providence Fire Chief James Alexander presented commendations to Lt. Michael Rohlfing and Battalion Chief Christopher Reynolds for their actions during a "mayday" situation that led to the rescue of a trapped firefighter during the January 26th Salter's fire. Lt. Rohlfing received the Medal of Valor Award which includes a written Citation, the Medal of Valor, and a Citation Bar. Battalion Chief Reynolds received an Award of Merit which includes a written citation and Citation Bar.
- Chief Alexander presented an Award of Merit to **Chief Engineer Kyle Lochner** who, along with a Norriton Fire Engine Co. member, pulled a trapped firefighter to safety during a February 6th dwelling fire in West Norriton Township.
