

Board of Supervisors' Actions – October 3, 2019 Business Meeting

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the October 3rd business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the Consent Agenda, including:
 - Minutes of the September 19, 2019 Board of Supervisors business meeting and the September 23, 2019 Board of Supervisors budget workshop
 - Letter of Credit Release 28 Eagleville Road in the amount of \$5,000
- Approved a request for waiver of fence standards to allow replacement fencing to be installed with framing facing outward to match the existing fencing at 110 Sarah Avenue
- Approved the Parks and Recreations Department's 5-Year Capital Plan

Resolution

• Approved <u>Resolution 2019-28</u> supporting an amendment to the Sterling Act to require that up to one percent of Philadelphia Wage Tax paid by non-residents of Philadelphia be remitted to the municipality in which the taxpayer resides.

Discussions

- Discussed a two-lot minor subdivision plan for 3880 Yerkes Road. Approval of the preliminary land development plan will be considered at the October 17th meeting.
- Supervisor Neights provided a sample ordinance that pertained to updating the Township's notification policy for zoning changes or amendments. The solicitor was asked to review the sample and complete modifications for presentation to the Board for review and consideration.
