



Board of Supervisors' Actions – December 5, 2019 Business Meeting

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the December 5th business meeting:

Resolutions

- Approved [Resolution 2019-34](#) adopting the 2020 Budget without a tax increase
- Approved [Resolution 2019-35](#) establishing the Real Estate Tax millage
- Approved [Resolution 2019-36](#) authorizing the disposition of records according to the PA Municipal Records Manual

Approvals

- Approved the release of escrow payment #10 for the Lower Providence EMS facility in the amount of \$29,452,94
- Approved a contract with James R. Kenney Excavating and Paving for 2020 equipment rental
- Approved a one-year contract using 100 percent green energy with Constellation Energy for the generation portion of the Township's electricity

Discussions

- Discussed the land development plan for 9 S. Park Avenue proposing the relocation of a tile business to the vacant building. The proposal also involves construction of two apartments on top of the existing building and a new 3000 sq. ft. storage extension. The plan has received conditional use approval for the mixed use. A decision on the plan will be on the Board's December 19 agenda.
- Discussed the formation of a Township Environmental Advisory Council. The Solicitor was requested to draft an ordinance establishing a Township Environmental Council for the Board's review and comment.
