LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the February 20th business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the consent agenda including:
 - Minutes of the January 16, 2020 Board of Supervisors meeting
 - Payment of bills in the amount of \$393,541.10
 - Escrow Release #1 for 141 Appledale Road in the amount of \$19,769.86
 - Escrow Release #4 for 37 Crawford Road in the amount of \$16,400.00
- Approved the following appointments to the Lower Providence Community Library Board of Trustees:
 - Tejal Mehta Term expires 2022
 - Shannon Chase Filling term expiring in 2020
- Authorized staff to proceed with repair of a culvert on Blue Teel Circle as required by a PennDOT inspection report. The repair will be done either as an emergency repair or by bidding the project, whichever is determined by PennDOT. Township staff will meet with PennDOT officials to determine the course of action needed.

Public Hearing

A Conditional Use Hearing was held pertaining to a proposed residential use for 420 Church Road and three adjacent properties. The proposal is for a Village House Development. Testimony was provided by the applicant, the Township and the public. The Board of Supervisors will render a decision within 45 days.
