**LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP** – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the March 5<sup>th</sup> business meeting:

### **Approvals**

- Approved the consent agenda including:
  - Minutes of the February 20, 2020 Board of Supervisors meeting
- Approved the advertisement of an ordinance creating a Township Environmental Advisory Council
- Authorized a one-year extension of the review process for Shannondell Phase III

### **Resolution**

- Approved [Resolution 2020-09](#) supporting the submission of a multi-municipal grant application for the Perkiomen Creek Water Trail Signage and Wayfinding Project. If awarded, the grant funds will be used to design and install water trail signage in key locations along the length of the Perkiomen Creek Water Trail. The Water Trail is operated by the Perkiomen Watershed Conservancy and is approximately 18 miles long, beginning at Green Lane Park and ending at the Perkiomen Creek's confluence with the Schuylkill River.

### **Presentations**

- Presentation of Distinguished Unit Citations to Off. W. Timothy Arthur, Off. Devon Auge, Off. Jeremy Bonner, Sgt. James Crawford, and Off. Michael Nastasi. The officers were recognized for their decisive and professional efforts during an incident in 2019.
