LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following action at the March 20th special meeting:

Approvals

- Approved [Resolution 2020-10](#) authorizing the continuance of the Township's Disaster Emergency Declaration of March 11, 2020 beyond the initial seven-day period. The resolution extends the declaration for an additional 60 days or until Gov. Wolf lifts the state disaster emergency.

The Disaster Emergency Declaration does not affect residents. It is needed for resource allocation only and enables the Township to expedite obtaining any needed resources and activating medical responders.

No other township business was considered during this special meeting. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the Township Building remains closed to the public. The meeting was available for viewing and public comment via live streaming on the internet.
