LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the April 16th business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the consent agenda including:
 - Minutes of the April 2, 2020 meeting of the Board of Supervisors
 - Authorization of payment of bills in the amount of \$302,274.88
 - Escrow releases:
 - Courts at Brynwood Phase II, release no. 3 in the amount of \$261,368.00
- Approved accepting the proposal of McMahon Associates for engineering for the PennDOT Green Light-Go grant project. Three traffic signals on Egypt Road, from Crawford Road to Surrey Lane, will be upgraded with the implementation of automated traffic signal performance measures (ATSPMs) with fiber optic communication, controller upgrades, and detection upgrades.
- Accepted the proposal from the Montgomery County Planning Commission to complete a Comprehensive Plan update for the Township
- Granted a waiver request to permit a six-foot high solid style fence to be installed at 338 Level Road (corner of Level and Stoughton roads)

Ordinances

- Adopted [Ordinance No. 666](#) repealing Article VI, section 143-36 of the Township Code (Ordinance No. 660) and revising zoning notification requirements
- Adopted [Ordinance No. 667](#) eliminating the Township's Per Capita Tax
