LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the August 20th business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the consent agenda including:
 - Minutes of the July 16, 2020 meeting of the Board of Supervisors
 - Treasurer's Report
 - Payment of bills in the amount of \$792,988.80
- Approved the request for waiver of fence standards to allow the installation of a solidstyle, six-foot fence partially in the front yard at 628 Mourning Dove Road.
- Approved the request for waiver of fence standards to permit the installation of a six-foot, solid-style fence on the corner property at 3001 Still Meadow Drive.
- Approved the request . for waiver of fence standards to permit the installation of a six-foot, solid-style fence in the front yard at 165 Regency Drive.
- Adopted Ordinance No. 670 restricting parking on a portion of Kriebel Mill Road.
- Appointed Irene Biju, Josephine James, Vijay Ramakrishnan and Charlie Yang as student representatives to the Board of Supervisors
- Appointed Jeffrey Gong, Kristen Riddel, Parmesh Sivakumar, and Riley McDonald as student representatives to the Parks and Recreation Board

Reviews

- Reviewed the land development plans for <u>Arrowhead Elementary School</u> from Methacton School District to reconstruct the existing school building. The project will involve continued operation of the existing building while the new school is being built. The new building will add a second story over part, enhanced traffic circulation, stormwater management, and modernized construction systems.
- Reviewed land development plans for <u>Moscariello at Crosskeys</u> Road, a proposal to develop vacant property at Crosskeys Road and Ridge Pike to include construction of 30 townhomes and three mixed-used building adjacent to Ridge Pike.
