

Board of Supervisors' Actions – October 15, 2020 Business Meeting

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LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at the October 15th business meeting:

Approvals

- Approved the Consent Agenda, including
 - Minutes of the <u>September 17, 2020</u> and <u>October 1, 2020</u> Board of Supervisors' meetings and the <u>September 29, 2020 Budget Workshop</u>
 - Payment of bills in the amount of \$1,692,769.38
- Approved the request for waiver of fence standards at 3794 Kim Road to permit solidstyle fencing along the edge of the front yard of the property
- Approved the request for waiver of fence standards at 137 Oaklyn Avenue to permit the replacement of a solid-style fence on the corner property
- Approved the request for waiver of fence standards at 900 Madison Avenue to permit
 the installation of two lengths of solid-style fencing on the corner property to partially
 conceal existing equipment in front of the building
- Approved an update to the Township Personnel Policy, Substance Abuse, to comply
 with updated requirements in the Code of Federal Regulations regarding all Township
 employees who are required to maintain a Commercial Drivers License (CDL)
