Board of Supervisors' Actions - May 19, 2016 Business Meeting

LOWER PROVIDENCE TOWNSHIP (*May 20, 2016*) – The Lower Providence Township Board of Supervisors took the following actions at their May 19th business meeting:

Ordinances

- Adopted an ordinance prohibiting trucks, except for local deliveries, on Arcola Road, between Eagleville Road and the Arcola Road Bridge, and on Level Road, between Lenape Road and the Arcola Road Bridge. The ordinance also re-establishes and restates truck restrictions and vehicle weight limits on other Township roads.
- Adopted an ordinance establishing a Riparian Buffer Overlay Zone (RBOZ) in order to
 protect stream banks, fish and animal habitats, and to conserve existing natural features
 important to land or water resources on developed and undeveloped land.
- Adopted an ordinance amending provisions of the Lower Providence Township restated Police Pension Plan to provide a service increment benefit and service-connected death benefit in accordance with the collective bargaining agreement.

Resolutions

 Adopted a resolution approving an intermunicipal agreement between Worcester Township, Lower Providence Township and the Lower Providence Township Sewer Authority. The ordinance permits certain properties located in Worcester Township that abut Lower Providence to connect to and be serviced by the Lower Providence Township sanitary sewer system.

Approvals

- Approved the appointment of Interim Township Manager Alison Rudolf as Assistant Treasurer
- Authorized the purchase of a Public Works dump truck
- Authorized the selection of McMahon Associates to proceed to the fee negotiation stage required the Multi-Modal Grant Project. The firm was selected from the three highest ranking candidates for the design contract for the realignment of the Crawford Road, Eagleville Road, and Park Avenue intersection. The Township has received a grant in the amount of \$1 million from the state Multi-Modal Transportation Fund.
