





### **Historic Preservation**

Create an inventory of cultural and historic resources in the township and conduct regular updates. Work with property owners to assess listed resources and potential resources for conservation and preservation opportunities.

- Become a "Certified Local Government" for access to grants and technical assistance for historic preservation.
- Adopt a historic preservation overlay to address the preservation of historic buildings and resources throughout the township.
