Workshop Findings

Visioning Exercise | 28 Participants, 124 responses

The Questions:

- What should we maintain or preserve?
 participants, 33 responses
- What can we repair or reimagine?23 participants, 48 responses
- What do you want to see in 2040?22 participants, 43 responses



Employment and Business Development

Key Points:

- Small businesses are a priority
- Businesses like flexibility in zoning
- ► Target vacancies, businesses benefit from neighbors
- Make business areas more community-oriented

Questions:

Where can this happen?

Commercial Character

- Make Ridge Pike a more attractive, walkable place
- Help Evansburg to be more like Skippack village
- More options for dining, entertainment, event venues, and retail
- Reuse or redevelop vacant places
- Want to look more like a Main Street

Natural Environment

- Flooding issues located
- Work with state on recreation, flood mitigation, building maintenance, safety in the state park
- Maintenance and best practices on public land
- Education and resources for property owners

Walking and Biking

- Sidewalk gaps, roads without sidewalks, crosswalks are concerns
- Snow plowing causes access issues at corners
- Lighting and signage would help
- Connections between neighborhoods, commercial areas, recreation, community destinations

Traffic and Transit

Key Points:

- Congestion, walkability, and crashes are concerns at major intersections (e.g. Ridge and Trooper, Audubon and Pawlings, Egypt and Trooper)
- Lack of sidewalks and walkability is a concern
- Suggestion to look at traffic light timing

Questions:

▶ How could transit be made more convenient in the township?

Housing and Neighborhoods

Key Points:

- Lack of options for first-time homebuyers and 55+
- Interest in downsizing and staying local
- Good variety of housing
- Demand is a sign of a successful community

Questions:

Where can new housing go?

Community Identity

- History, convenient location, distinct villages, parks and open spaces, community activities set Lower Providence apart
- School, youth leagues, community events, public engagement contribute to township's involvement and inclusion
- Celebrate history and diversity
- "A community of villages"

Vision Statement

- Develop the local economy
- Use what works, it doesn't have to be original
- Embrace new ways, celebrate history
- Strengthen sense of community
- Respect differences, value diversity


Survey Update


- 44 responses as of April 20 (41 answering "yes" as township residents)
- Averaging 10 minutes to complete
- No drop-off issues (leaving the survey incomplete)
- ▶ 56% to 100% response rate for open-ended questions




