Call to Order: Member Erin McCool called the virtual Zoom meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

1. Approval of Minutes

a. **MOTION:** Mr. Zollers made a motion to approve the March 15, 2021 meeting minutes. Mr. Lulis seconded the motion. The motion *passed 4-0*.

2. New/Old Business

- a. Earth Day Activities Recap Ms. McCool reviewed the weeklong activities that took place with the culmination at the JJ Audubon Center on Sunday, April 18th. Each EAC member commented on the activities and as a group will put together some ideas that will help improve the events next year. It was noted that the planning should begin much earlier like in January. A review of the creek clean-up activities was also reviewed. Mr. Zollers requested the "Skippack Creek" task; Ms. Baird requested the "Piping Infrastructure" task; Mr. Lulis requested the "Areas with Storm Water Drainage Issues" task; Ms. McCool suggested that she and Mr. Duffy work on the "Community Involvement" task; and it was recommended that the "Funding Resources" task be addressed as they further develop the programs. It was agreed that the EAC would come back next month with a more definitive plan on how to move forward addressing these tasks.
- c. Priorities and projects outside of stormwater directive The group reviewed the list that had been generated at last month's EAC meeting and who would be responsible for each category/item. The group discussed the potential workshops for the remainder of this year which could include the Perkiomen Watershed Storm Water Workshop, Mascaro Recycling Workshop, and a Composting Workshop. The group will finalize the list and present to the Board of Supervisors at the May 6th public meeting.
