Junior Police Academy – 2024

Dates of Academy: June 13th & June 14th 2024 (Thursday and Friday)

Times of Academy: 8AM – 3PM (Both Days) (Drop off between 7:50AM – 8:00AM)

Academy Graduation: June 14th from 2:30-3:00PM (Parents/Family Welcome, arrive at 2:15PM)

Cadets Eligibility: Cadets must reside within the Methacton School District and be between the ages 10 – 13, a Cadet with prior negative police contact may be disqualified, each Cadet will be looked at on an individual basis.

Location of Academy: The Academy will be held both days at the Arcola Intermediate School. The school is located at 4001 Eagleville Road, Eagleville, PA in Lower Providence Township.

Dressing for the Academy: The Academy will provide an Academy T-Shirt, which must be worn both days of the Academy. Due to expected warm weather, cadets should apply sunscreen and wear gym shorts/sneakers both days.

Meals/Drinks: All Cadets will be provided with a personal water bottle which shall be brought each day of the Academy. Cadets will have snacks/drinks provided throughout both days. Lunch will also be provided each day for the Cadets (Pizza & Hoagies). If your child requires a different lunch due to dietary needs, they will need to bring it & we have refrigerators available to use.

Photographs/Video: Photographs/Video of the Cadets may be taken during the Academy. These images may be used by Lower Providence Township, News Organizations and/or Sponsors.

Additional Information: During the Academy the Cadets will be outdoors and will be playing games. It will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to dispense any medications. Police Academy personnel will not administer any medications (unless in an emergency situation).

Notice of Acceptance into Academy: The Junior Police Academy will be open to the *first 50 eligible cadet applicants*. Applications will be accepted March 20th – April 15th. The parents will be notified of the Cadet's acceptance via email/phone call within 3-weeks after the application deadline is reached.
