I. PURPOSE:

The department and community wish to recognize an officer for excellence in law enforcement and/or their accomplishments and deeds on an annual basis.

II. ELIGIBILITY:

Any active duty officer that is in good standing with the department employed for the twelve month period prior to selection.

III. CRITERIA:

To be nominated for the Officer of the Year Award the person may meet:

- 1. Exemplary service; or
- 2. Excellence in police work, or outstanding performance of duties under unusual, complicated, or hazardous conditions; or
- 3. Outstanding performance over a prolonged period of time or for designing and implementing exemplary problem solving projects in cooperation with the community; or
- 4. Awarded for heroic deed of courage at risk of personal safety, or for meritorious service above and beyond the call of duty in assignments of great responsibility; or
- 5. Awarded for conspicuous act of gallantry and heroism, in circumstances where the officer was fully aware of the threat and acted at the risk of life and limb.

IV. NOMINATIONS:

May be made by any regular member of the organization and shall include at least the following information:

- 1. Notification by the chief that nominations are open
- 2. Name of nominee
- 3. Squad or unit assigned
- 4. Narrative of action(s) or contribution(s) to law enforcement or organization
- 5. Person submitting
- 6. Any documentation or others supporting the nomination

V. SELECTION:

- 1. Review of nominations by the Chief, Lieutenant and one Sergeant
 - a. Review will include the specifics of all nominations
 - b. Performance review
 - c. Conduct review
- 2. Notification to award recipient
- 3. Notification to department
- 4. Award ceremony at the Optimist Club Respect for Law dinner
 - a. Officer Plaque
 - b. Department Plaque
