## **ARMED SUSPECT**

160 Level Road – Warrior Field

On Wednesday, October 13, 2021 at 9:37 PM, a citizen called 9-1-1 to report that a female was armed with a firearm, causing a disturbance and brandishing that firearm at Warrior Field, located at 160 Level Road, Lower Providence Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. While officers were still enroute, Montgomery County Communications advised that the female suspect left the area. During the investigation it was discovered that she may be heading to Norristown Borough. Officers requested the assistance of Norristown Police with locating the suspect vehicle. At 9:59 PM, Norristown Police located the suspect vehicle at Dekalb Street and East Spruce Street. A handgun was observed to be in the vehicle, located on the floor of the front passenger seat and the suspect was taken into custody without further incident. The suspect is identified as Gabrielle Ariana Scott, 29, of Lansdale, Pennsylvania.

Scott has been charged with Aggravated Assault, Possessing Instruments of Crime, and Recklessly Endangering Another Person. She was provided a preliminary arraignment before Magisterial District Judge Michael P. Quinn of Narberth. Scott was released on \$10,000 unsecured bail. A preliminary hearing is scheduled before Magisterial District Judge Cathleen Rebar on October 26, 2021.

Lower Providence Township Police Department is committed to transparency. However, a complete investigative process requires information to be limited to maintain the integrity of the investigation. For this reason, only preliminary details that do not compromise the investigation may be released at this time.
