

Park Avenue/Eagleville Road/Crawford Road Intersection Improvement Project

Progress Update

January 5, 2017

McMahon Associates, the firm appointed by the Township to perform the preliminary engineering and design phase for the project, reports that it has completed its field survey. Traffic counts for the intersection were completed in December and crash data/analysis is currently being reviewed. Additionally, roadway design criteria have been established and conceptual alignments for various intersection alternatives are being developed. Finally, the early stage of the necessary environmental survey work is underway.

The project will realign the Park Avenue/Eagleville Road/Crawford Road intersection. The Township secured a \$1,000,000 grant from the Multimodal Transportation Fund from PennDOT to perform this preliminary engineering and final design work. While this analysis and design phase is progressing, the Township will continue to seek grant funding for the construction phase of the project. Lower Providence currently has \$2,300,000 from Audubon Land Development to apply toward the project. In addition, we have submitted another Multimodal Transportation Grant application in the amount of \$2,000,000.
